Deacons in the Episcopal Church are ordained to bring the needs of the world to the Church and lead the Church in service to others. The Deacons Closet helps us live into that call — sharing compassion in practical, meaningful ways.

Food (non-perishable, easy to open)

- Canned meats (tuna, chicken, spam, Vienna sausages)
- Soups, chili, or stew (pop-top lids preferred)
- Peanut butter and crackers
- Granola or protein bars
- Instant oatmeal packets
- Fruit cups or applesauce (pop-top lids preferred)
- Bottled water and juice boxes

Personal Hygiene (Travel Size Preferred)

- Toothbrushes & toothpaste
- Soap, shampoo, deodorant
- Feminine hygiene products
- Razors, shaving cream
- Hand sanitizer, wipes, lotion

Cold Weather & Outdoor Gear
